Inaugurated in April 2002, the World Gourmet Summit (WGS) Awards of Excellence Scholarships were established for aspiring food and beverage professionals who are eager for self-improvement, personal development and possess the potential to grow in the culinary and food and beverage profession.

For 2003, the Scholarships will include a Patisserie Scholarship which will be awarded by Cacao Barry. The Culinary Scholarship will again be awarded by Le Cordon Bleu, and the Wine Scholarship will be awarded by renowned winery from Spain, Bodegas Torres Winery.

Le Cordon Bleu Culinary Scholarship

The scholar will have the opportunity to attend a culinary course at Le Cordon Bleu. The course will cover essential topics such as product origins, various cooking techniques, and presentation, and theory.

The awarded scholar will be able to receive:

- Le Cordon Bleu Culinary Course at Le Cordon Bleu
- return air ticket
- accommodation

Applicants will be required to undertake:

Phase 1 – Written Examination

Phase 2 – Practical Cooking (1 Appetizer and 1 Main Dish)

– Personal Interview



Cacao Barry Patisserie Scholarship

The scholar will have the opportunity to spend two weeks at Cacao Barry E'Cole in France and at the distinguished Culinary Institute Alain & Marie LeNotre, France. The entire programme will cover various aspects of pastry and dessert making.

The awarded scholar will receive:

- two-week patisserie apprenticeship at Cacao Barry E'Cole, and Culinary Institute Alain & Marie LeNotre, France
- return air ticket
- accommodation

Applicants will be required to undertake:

Phase 1 – Written Examination

Phase 2 – Practical Cooking (2 desserts, of which 1 must be chocolate based)

– Personal Interview

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Bodegas Torres Wine Scholarship

The scholar will have the opportunity to spend three weeks at the renowned Bodegas Torres Winery in Spain to learn about the intricacies of wine making. The three-week programme will cover topics such as viticulture, yeast study, fermentation, wine making (red and white wines), quality control, sensorial analysis, and ageing in oak barrels.

The awarded scholar will receive

- three-week apprenticeship at Bodegas Torres Winery, Spain
- return air ticket
- accommodation

Applicants will be required to undertake:

Phase 1 – Written Examination

Phase 2 – Blind Tasting

who SHOULD APPLY

- Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents of Singapore between the ages of 18 to 26
- have a minimum of three GCE 'O' Level passes with credit in English
- currently working in the food & beverage industry or currently a student of food & beverage, or culinary course
- have at least 120 hours of commercial cooking or restaurant service experience

All qualified candidates for the three scholarships will be required to sit for a Written Examination on 23 November 2002. Six candidates with the highest scores will be selected from each category for a Practical Test followed by a Personal Interview.
