Unique Dining

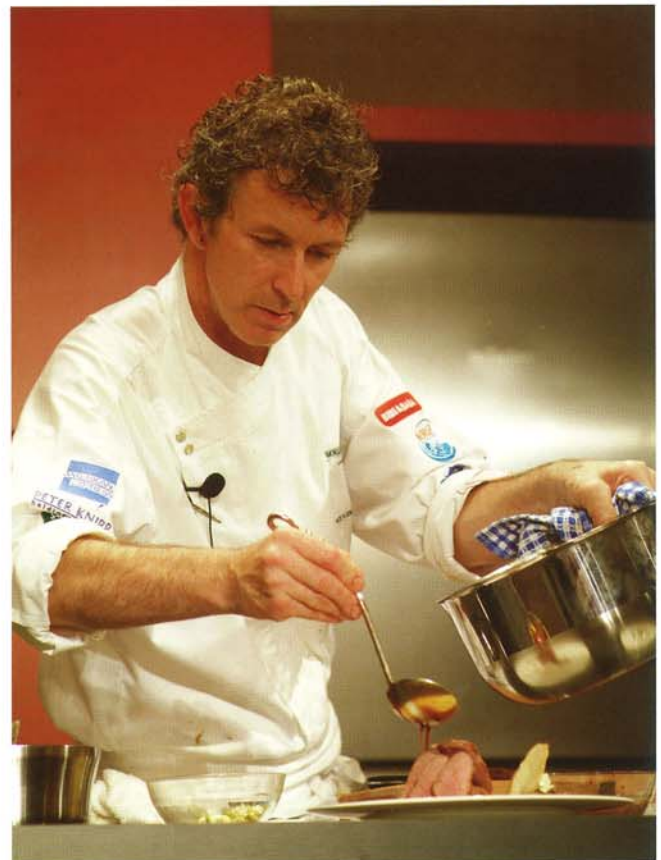
